

## Online Portuguese for Foreigners (Advanced)

### Level 3

#### Subjects:

- Doing a research – planning;
  - Getting used to the Brazilian terminology and methodology;
  - Preparing a brief research project;
  - Preparing a survey.
- Doing a research – execution:
  - Learning how to write a review (review);
  - Preparing a slide presentation with the research results;
  - Presenting the research in the classroom.
- Concluding a subject in a Brazilian university (graduation):
  - Study group:
    - Debating a point of view with my classmate;
    - Strategic conflicts of ideas;
    - Exemplification.
  - Final exam:
    - Conventions for exams in Brazil (prior announcement of the context, type of questions, open book or not, etc.)
    - Taking the exam:
      - Identifying types of questions;
      - Choosing the most appropriate method to answer that question.
- Conclusion Article/Essay (paper):
  - Getting to know ABNT standards (format, citations and references);
  - Getting to know some verbs, expressions and categories used in the written for academic papers;
  - Textual planning.
- Writing the final paper:
  - Introducing a question;
  - Citing authors (agreeing or disagreeing)
  - Opposing arguments;
  - Taking a position;
  - Developing conclusions.

#### COURSE SYLLABUS:

- Common idiomatic expressions of complex structuration of the Brazilian Portuguese, focusing on the typical structures of the school/academic context of Brazil, aiming to attend real needs.

- Review of competences and content addressed on Portuguese for Foreigners Level 2, with increase of vocabulary and more complex phrasal and textual structures;
- Linguistics structures recurring in the oral and written texts in the Brazilian academic contexts.
